- MKA follows a modified FCI 7 Group system. For more info about MKA groups please visit www.dogsmalaysia.my
- To qualify for the title of Malaysian Champion a dog must be over 15 months old and win 3 CAC. Those below 15 months are eligible for the Malaysian Junior Champion title by winning 3 JCAC.
- MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) & Junior Challenge Certificates (JCAC) will be awarded at all shows **in every class**. CACIB'S will be awarded at the FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOWS, to exhibits entered in the **Intermediate and Open class ONLY**. There is **NO** Champion Class on offer at these shows.
- Winners of the MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) at the **17th & 18th MKA FCI ASIA PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** will be awarded APAC Champion CAC which goes towards their FCI APAC Champion Title.
- Winners of Dog & Bitch CAC, Dog & Bitch winners from the Junior Class in Breed & Dog & Bitch winners from the Veteran Class in Breed at the **51st MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW** will be eligible for the title of **Malaysian Winner 2019, Malaysian Junior Winner 2019 & Malaysian Veteran Winner 2019**.
- All Dog & Bitch CACIB winners **AND** Dog and Bitch winners from the Junior Class in breeds recognized by the London Kennel Club at the **53rd MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW 2019** will qualify to enter **CRUFTS 2020**.
- Winners of the MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) at the **9th MKA SOUTH EAST ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** will be awarded SEA Champion CAC which goes towards their SEA Champion Title.
- This is a Back to Back show, so entries have to be made for both shows on each day.

General Information

Quarantine Waiver

****Overseas Exhibitors Please take note****

Due to a recent change in government legislation, the MKA is unable to get quarantine waiver for overseas dogs wishing to participate at these shows. Any overseas dogs wishing to participate will have to complete 7 or 14 days quarantine (depending where they come from) before being allowed to participate.

Only dogs from **Japan, Singapore, New Zealand, Sweden, Ireland and the UK** are allowed to enter without quarantine and only for breeds that are not restricted.

Please take note that for the following breeds of dogs will not be granted Quarantine Waiver even if they come from one of the Rabies free countries mentioned above:

Please take note that the following breeds are **BANNED** by the Malaysian government from entering the country :

Neapolitan Mastiff	Fila Brasileiro	Pit Bull Terrier/Pit Bull (also known as American Pit Bull, American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier and Staffordshire Bull Terrier)	

All overseas participants **MUST** submit all entries ONLINE at www.dogsmalaysia.my on or before **6pm, 22nd March 2019**

Import Permits

The MKA will be organizing the application of Import permits and Waiver of Quarantine for All overseas exhibitors. The fee payable for this service is **RM175 per dog**. All overseas participants are also required to pay **RM150** Admin Charge per owner.

Export Permits

The MKA will be unable to organise the Export Permit and Health Certificate applications on your behalf, so foreign exhibitors will have to apply for these permits either on **Thursday 4th April or on Monday 8th April 2019**. You will be required to go to the Dept of Veterinary Services Office in Shah Alam to apply for this. We can assist you in applying for the Export Permit in advance, but you have to go to the office yourself for the inspection and stamping of paperwork. We advise that you **DO NOT** book your flights till Tuesday 9th April 2019 if you are doing the inspection on Monday 8th April. Costs are roughly: Inspection Fee is **RM75 per exhibitor** and cost for Export Permit & Health Cert is **RM60 per dog**. Fee is subject to change.

Vaccinations

All Vaccinations, including Rabies Vaccinations must be done at least 30 days before arrival in Malaysia and Vaccination cards **MUST be endorsed** by the Competent Authority (Government Vet Dept) and not just private Veterinary practice.

Microchips

All dogs entering Malaysia **MUST be microchipped** with a 15 digit **ISO certified** and readable microchip. The microchip numbers will be checked on entry into and on departure from KLIA. If you are using an AVID

chip you MUST bring along your own microchip scanner. Otherwise **AVID chips will NOT be allowed.**

Import Clearance

For Import clearance all Dogs entering Malaysia must produce – Original Export Health Cert from Country of Export, Original Export Permit from Country of Export and also Import permit for return to Country of origin.

Arrival & Departure

All overseas exhibits must arrive in Malaysia via the designated entry point, Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) .

Acceptance of Entries

A reminder that the MKA will only accept entries from overseas participants who have obtained the Import permit through us and whose dogs originating from one of the approved RABIES FREE countries.

Payment

Entries for ALL overseas entries **MUST** be made online via our website www.dogsmalaysia.my We strongly advise you to put your entries in well in advance so that we are able to help you out should there be any problems. **Full amount for your transport services need to be paid direct to the relevant parties. Refundable Security Deposit of RM250 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. The Landlord will return security deposit to you directly upon checking out.**

Transportation

a) Private Van Hire

The cost of hiring a private van for a day (12 hours) is RM650.

b) Airport & Show pick up and drop off service

Price for **ONE WAY** is **RM200** for –

3 Small crates (Yorkie/Maltese/Shih Tzu size) **PLUS 2 passengers, OR**

2 Medium crates (Beagle size) **PLUS 2 passengers, OR**

1 Large crate (Siberian/Golden size) **PLUS 2 passengers.**

(For giant crates please make a separate inquiry.)

c) Daily Shuttle from Homestay (Setia Eco area only) to Show Venue (Drop Off and Pick Up Only)

Price is RM350 per day.

Accommodation

All hotels in Malaysia will not allow dogs into their hotels due to their Halal Status. As such we can assist you to book homestays if you require our assistance or you can make your own bookings accordingly.

Private Bungalow House (10 minutes drive from show venue)

We have managed to get a private Bungalow house where you can stay together with your dogs in the bedrooms. There is a large garden for you to let your dogs loose to exercise. You have to bring your own towels and toiletries as this is a home stay concept Bungalow. All rooms are air-conditioned.

Cost per night

Twin room – RM200

Refundable Security Deposit of RM250 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. The Landlord will return security deposit to you directly upon checking out.

If you are staying at this venue you will have to hire a private van, to transport you to the show venue and back. This will be a separate charge. Depending on the number of people choosing to stay here and the breeds of dogs here, we may be able to determine if a van can be shared. The cost of hiring a private van for a day (12 hours) is RM700. See above for shared shuttle charge from Bungalow to Show Venue.

All overseas participants **MUST** submit all entries ONLINE at www.dogsmalaysia.my on or before **6pm, 22nd March 2019**

If any of the required forms are missing or illegible, we reserve the right to reject the application. We recommend you do your online entries early, so we can contact you if anything is missing or illegible!!

Deposits taken whilst paying online for accommodation & anything else will be refunded to you by the MKA at the dog show. Full amounts for these services need to be paid direct to the relevant parties.

General MKA Show rules

1. **General Cleanliness at Shows** - Exhibitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to pick up/clean their dogs poo and pee at ANY show venues. Exhibitors who trim/groom their dogs at shows are also responsible for picking up their dog fur. **Exhibitors caught breaking these cleanliness rules will be given an automatic two show ban.** All dogs owned and co-owned by them at the time of the offence, will also automatically be suspended from two shows, even if they are transferred to new owners.
2. **Illness** - The MKA shall not be liable for any form of illness or disease that dogs may contract at a show. Exhibitors are required to take every reasonable precaution to prevent the introduction of diseased or sick animals to the Show. The sale of young puppies at the show venue is strictly prohibited.

3. Any dog entered must not have been registered or recorded as having been owned, boarded or handled by the Judge within the period of six (6) months immediately preceding the show. The only exception shall be in the case where an emergency Judge is appointed to replace the advertised Judge.
4. **Withdrawal of Exhibits** - Exhibitors who have won In-Group Awards do not wish to stay for BIS Specials, must fill up the **Leave of Absence** form and submit it to the Show Manager. This is to save the CRS and Calling Stewards from wasting time calling for your exhibit numbers during the BIS judging. If the Leave of Absence form is not submitted, then any awards and points won by your dog during the entire show will be revoked.
5. **Exhibition of Imported & Malaysian Bred Dogs** - Imported dogs whose application for re-registration is past the 6 month grace period and who have not yet obtained a local MKA registration number cannot be exhibited. All Malaysian bred dogs above 6 months old without MKA registration numbers also cannot be exhibited.
6. **Collecting Ring** – MKA members who are not exhibiting their dogs are not allowed into the collecting ring. Non MKA members and members of the public are also prohibited from entering the collecting area for their own safety.
7. **Non MKA Member handlers** - If a Handler is not a Registered Member of the MKA, the registered owner/s of the dog will be responsible for the actions of the handler. Expelled or suspended members of the MKA are **not** allowed to Handle dogs in the ring. All foreign exhibitors who are showing here temporarily can do so, so long as they are registered members of their respective local Canine authorities that are recognized and have reciprocal agreements with the MKA. If a Handler is not a Registered Member of the MKA, they will be required to sign up as a **Day Member** of the MKA on the day of the show on the prescribed form. Charge for Day membership is RM20.
8. **3 Calls Rule** – It is the responsibility of exhibitors to have their dogs ready at ringside for judging. If exhibits are not presented on time for judging, upon 3 calls by the steward of your exhibit number, your exhibit will be automatically scratched from further participation (even in subsequent classes) unless allowed by the judge. Only the judge and not CRS has the authority to allow exhibits that are scratched back for judging.

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
