Introduction of Malaysian Junior Champion & Revision of Malaysian Champion title

Junior Champion title

Effective **1**st **January 2017**, the MKA will be introducing the Junior Champion title for dogs entered in the Puppy and Junior Classes (6-15 months old).

At shows organised by the MKA, there will be two sets of Challenge Certificates (CC) for every breed :

- 1. Junior CC for dogs entered in the Puppy & Junior Class.
- 2. Adult CC (which will just be called the CC) for dogs entered in the Intermediate, Open & Veteran Classes **PLUS** dogs entered in the Malaysian bred class **over the age of 15 months**.

Dogs under the age of 15 months can also enter the Malaysian bred class but they **MUST** also enter either the Puppy or Junior class to be eligible for the Junior CC.

After the judging of the Puppy and Junior class for each sex, the judge will award the Junior CC & RCC for the winners of these two classes for each sex. The other classes will then be judged and Adult CC & RCC awarded for the other class winners for each sex in those classes.

Best of Breed will be decided between the winners of the Junior CC and Adult CC. RCC winners of either Junior and Adult CC can compete for Reserve Best of Breed if the corresponding winner of their category is selected as Best of Breed.

To become a Malaysian Junior Champion a dog must win the following:

- 3 Junior CC
- 2 Junior CC plus 3 Junior RCC
- 1 Junior CC plus 6 Junior RCC

The MYS JR CH title will be officially added to your dog's pedigree name. To receive the official Champion Certificate, an application needs to be made the MKA inclusive of the fee of RM50 (inc. GST).


Malaysian Champion title

The qualification for Malaysian Champion title is now **only available** to dogs entered in the Intermediate, Open & Veteran Classes **PLUS** dogs entered in the Malaysian bred class **over the age of 15 months**.

The qualification to become a Malaysian champion remain unchanged as follows:

- 3 CC
- 2 CC plus 3 RCC
- 1 CC plus 6 RCC

For dogs qualifying for the title of MYS CH title in 2017, the title will be officially added to your dog's pedigree name. If you wish to receive the official Champion Certificate, an application needs to be made the MKA inclusive of the fee of RM50 (inc. GST).

Existing CC's won by dogs

CC's won by dogs prior to 1st January 2017 will still be valid and will count towards the MYS CH title. The only difference being that to complete the title of MYS CH after 1st January 2017, the dog must be over the age of 15 months.

As this is a new system being implemented by the MKA, we reserve the right to make amendments should any unforeseen issue arise.
