## **Terms & Conditions of Entry to MKA Dog Shows**

## **General Notes:**

- 1. This Entry Form is to be used by Members of the MKA only. There is a RM50 surcharge PER DOG to submit this entry form.
- Details of the Exhibit(s) & Exhibitor(s) must be as shown on the MKA Pedigree Certificate. The transfer or application for transfer must be submitted together with the entry form if the Exhibit is not yet registered with the MKA or transferred to the Exhibitor's name.
- The Exhibitor must countersign all alterations and corrections on the Entry Form and forms that are incomplete or those with incorrect details or without the appropriate fees will be rejected.
- Adult Malaysian Champions (not Junior Ch.) MUST automatically enter the Champion Class, but may also additionally compete in the Malaysian Bred, to compete for those respective In Group and In Show Awards. Proof of Champion titles must be provided at time of entry.
- 5. Veteran dogs that are also Malaysian Champions can either choose to enter the Veteran or Champion class, but not both.
- Champion Class is strictly for Dogs/Bitches over 15 months old with an Adult Champion title (<u>not</u> Junior Champion) from an FCI Member country only.
- Overseas Champions (from FCI member countries) who want to compete for the title of Malaysian Champion, MUST enter the Intermediate or Open Class, unless special exemption rules are in place for visiting foreign dogs at FCI International Shows.

## **General Show Entry Rules & Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Dogs with Docked Tails & Cropped Ears as docking of tails and cropping of ears is legal in Malaysia, at MKA National Shows (CAC), the following 11 breeds (Dobermann (143), Boxer (144), Rottweiler (147), Schnauzer (182, 183 & 185), German Pinscher (184), Miniature Pinscher (185), Neopolitan Mastiff (197), Great Dane (235), Italian Corso Dog (343) that were customarily docked and/or cropped, will be allowed to be shown docked and/or cropped and will be fully at the judge's discretion what they are awarded. In spite of amended FCI Breed Standards belonging to these traditionally docked and/or cropped breeds for which no reference is now made to the docking and cropping, the MKA chooses to utilise amended MKA breed standards, which allows these 11 breeds to be exhibited docked and/or cropped.
  - At MKA organised FCI International (CACIB) Shows, as per FCI Rules on Docking of tails & Cropping of ears, the following 11 breeds can only be shown docked or cropped, if they were born **before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025**. These breeds are as follows Dobermann (143), Boxer (144), Rottweiler (147), Schnauzer (182, 183 & 185), German Pinscher (184), Miniature Pinscher (185), Napolitan Mastiff (197), Great Dane (235), Italian Corso Dog (343).
  - Having read the above terms and conditions, those entering an MKA National and/or MKA FCI International Show, this show hereby declare that they are aware of the above ruling and enter knowing that cropped and/or docked dogs will be allowed to compete at MKA National (CAC) Shows and cropped and/or docked dogs born before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025 will be allowed to compete against dogs with natural tails and ears, and will not hold the FCI, the MKA or the Judge liable.
- 2. General Cleanliness at Shows Exhibitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to pick up/clean their dogs poo and pee at ANY show venues. Exhibitors who trim/groom their dogs at shows are also responsible for picking up their dog fur. Exhibitors caught breaking these cleanliness rules will be given an automatic two show ban. All dogs owned and co-owned by them at the time of the offence, will also automatically be suspended from two shows, even if they are transferred to new owners.
- 3. Illness The MKA shall not be liable for any form of illness or disease that dogs may contract at a show. Exhibitors are required to take every reasonable precaution to prevent the introduction of diseased or sick animals to the Show. The sale of young puppies at the show venue is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Any dog entered must not have been registered or recorded as having been owned, boarded or handled by the Judge within the period of six (6) months immediately preceding the show. The only exception shall be in the case where an emergency Judge is appointed to replace the advertised Judge.
- 5. **Withdrawal of Exhibits** Exhibitors who have won In-Group Awards do not wish to stay for BIS Specials, must get the consent of the Show Manager before leaving. If consent is not received, then any awards and points won by your dog during the entire show will be revoked.
- 6. Exhibition of Imported & Malaysian Bred Dogs Imported dogs whose application for re-registration is past the 6 month grace period and who have not yet obtained a local MKA registration number cannot be exhibited. All Malaysian bred dogs above 6 months old without MKA registration numbers also cannot be exhibited.
- 7. Non MKA Member handlers If a Handler is not a Registered Member of the MKA, the registered owner/s of the dog will be responsible for the actions of the handler. Expelled or suspended members of the MKA are not allowed to Handle dogs in the ring. All foreign exhibitors who are showing here temporarily can do so, so long as they are registered members of their respective local Canine authorities that are recognized and have reciprocal agreements with the MKA. If a Handler is not a Registered Member of the MKA, they will be required to sign up as a Day Member of the MKA on the day of the show on the prescribed form and pay the relevant fee. This is however not applicable to expelled or suspended members of the MKA or of any FCI NCO.
- 3 Calls Rule It is the responsibility of exhibitors to have their dogs ready at ringside for judging. If exhibits are not presented on time for judging, upon 3 calls by the steward of your exhibit number, your exhibit will be automatically scratched from further participation (even in subsequent classes).
