#### Carefully read this page before making your entry.

The MKA has managed to get Quarantine waiver for overseas dogs wishing to participate at these shows from all countries, subject to certain guidelines being strictly followed. The MKA will assist with all applications for the Malaysian Import & Export Permits and Health Certificates.

#### **Closing Dates for Overseas Entries**

Closing Date is 6pm (GMT +8) 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025. All entries have to be made online via our website.

#### **Restricted & Banned Breeds**

Certain breeds of dogs are by law banned in Malaysia or under restrictions for Import, which restricts their entry under Quarantine Waiver. For a list of those breeds, please read detailed information in the General Information section. See Page 13.

#### Dogs from Indonesia

Dog's MUST have a valid Rabies Titre Certificate. For further details please read detailed information in the General Information section. See Page 13.

#### Arrival & Departure Dates

**Grooming Exhibitors** – those bringing their own dogs and not hiring local model dogs **MUST arrive on 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept 2025** to do the Government Health Certification on 24<sup>th</sup> Sept 2025 at 8.30am. You will only be able to depart on 26<sup>th</sup> Sept after we process Export Permits and Health Certs and will not be able to leave any earlier, so please take note before booking flights.

**Dog Show Exhibitors** – you may arrive on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2025, but must arrive latest by 24<sup>th</sup> Sept to do the Government Health Certification on 25<sup>th</sup> Sept 2025 at 8.30am. You will only be able to depart on 29<sup>th</sup> Sept after we process Export Permits and Health Certs and will not be able to leave earlier, so please take note before booking flights.

## All exhibitors with dogs, MUST leave Malaysia on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025 and cannot arrive before 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2025.

#### **Accommodation for Exhibitors**

To comply with Government Quarantine Waiver, you MUST stay at the specially allocated accommodation that are listed as Home Quarantine Centers.

LYF Hotel – the hotel will strictly only accept **dogs under 10kg**, with a max of **3 dogs per room**.

Homestay Houses – those with dogs **over 10kg** have to select the homestay option for accommodation. If you are exhibiting dogs that are both under and over 10kg, you MUST choose the homestay option. The hotel and homestay houses are not close by, so it will not be possible to stay at both and we advise choosing the homestay house option. See page 5.

#### **Application Information**

The application for Import and Export Permits and Health Certs must be made in the name of the person travelling to and from Malaysia with the dogs, not the name of the Owner. The flight booking details and passport info required will also be for the person travelling with the dogs. Kindly pay attention to this before making your entry, as once the application is lodged, it is not possible to change the details of the person or their flight info.

# ALL Exhibitors



#### **Quarantine Waiver**

The MKA has managed to get Quarantine waiver for overseas dogs wishing to participate at these shows from all countries. All dogs must have valid Rabies Vaccinations and regular vaccinations to enable them entry under the Quarantine Waiver scheme.

#### **Import & Export Permits**

The MKA will organise the application of Import permits & Waiver of Quarantine and the Export Permit & Health Certificates for **All** overseas exhibitors.

The inspection of dogs for the Export Permit and Health certs at the Government Vet Dept on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> Sept at 8.30am for those bringing dogs for the Grooming Certification and Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> & Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> Sept at 8.30am for those attending the conformation dog shows. The MKA will organise and pay for the transportation from your accommodation to the Government Vet and return at the allotted times only.

## We strongly recommend that you do not book your return flights till <u>after 12pm</u> on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> Sept for Grooming Dogs and Monday 29<sup>th</sup> Sept for conformation dog show dogs, in case of any issues with the issuing of Export Permits and Health Certificates.

The fee payable for this service for Import & Export Permits plus Health Certs is **RM900 for the first dog** and **RM550 each** for the second and subsequent dog travelling with the same owner/handler (dogs must be booked to fly under the name of this person).

The fees for dogs from Hong Kong, Taiwan and Japan will be as follows, due to the extra paperwork required by your country of origin. **RM1100 for the first dog** and **RM550 each** for the second and subsequent dog travelling with the same owner/handler (dogs must be booked to fly with this named person).

Please note that these fees are subject to change and the extra to be paid at the show. All these charges will be collected at the time of Online registration and are <u>NON REFUNDABLE</u>.

If handlers are travelling with multiple dogs, we advise you to do the online registration at the same time, to avoid being charged additional charges. YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO AMEND or ADD ADDITIONAL DOGS after you have made the initial online entry. Subsequent entries will be considered as a new entry and charged as such.

#### Vaccinations

All General Vaccinations and Rabies Vaccinations must be done no less than 31 days (with the exception of dogs from Indonesia – see above) <u>before arrival into Malaysia</u>. Vaccination cards MUST be endorsed by the Competent Authority (Government Vet Dept) and not just private Veterinary practice.

#### Microchips

All dogs entering Malaysia **MUST** be microchipped with a **15 digit ISO certified** and readable microchip. The microchip numbers will be checked on entry into and on departure from KLIA. If you are using an AVID chip you MUST bring along your own microchip scanner. Otherwise <u>AVID</u> chips will NOT be allowed.

#### Import Clearance

For Import clearance all Dogs entering Malaysia must produce – Original Export Health Cert from Country of Export, Original Export Permit from Country of Export and also Import permit for return to Country of origin.

#### **Arrival & Departure**

All overseas exhibits must arrive in Malaysia via the designated entry point, Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) no earlier than **Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2025** and must depart on or before **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.

#### **Acceptance of Entries**

The MKA will only accept entries from overseas participants who have obtained the Import permit through us.

#### **Online Entries & Payment**

Entries for ALL overseas entries <u>MUST</u> be made online via our website <u>www.dogsmalaysia.my</u> Please CREATE an ONLINE account, before attempting to register your entries.

We strongly advise you register your entries in good time, so that we are able to help you out should there be any problems.

#### Accommodation

All foreign Exhibitors MUST stay at the accommodation arranged by the MKA as these are the registered Home Quarantine Units designated by the Quarantine Officers. You will not be allowed to participate or enter the show, if you do not select accommodation from the list we provide. **As such we have very limited accommodation on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.** 

We currently have 2 options for accommodation, according to the size of your dog. All accommodation is about 35-45 minutes away from the show venue, so you will need to organise private transport to get to the show. Please see the Transport option details below for more information. This will be a separate charge. Depending on the number of people choosing to stay at each location and the breeds of dogs here, you may be able to share a van.

**Hotel Accommodation (DOGS <u>UNDER</u> 10KG)** - If your dog is UNDER 10KG then you can choose the hotel option. There is a MAX of 3 dogs only allowed per room. If you have more than 3 dogs you will need to book multiple rooms.

Homestay Accommodation (DOGS <u>OVER</u> 10KG) - If your dog is over 10KG then you MUST take the homestay option. IF you have a mixture of dogs over and under 10kg, then you <u>must</u> take this homestay option.

We will reject applications made that have not correctly chosen accommodation according to the size and number of dogs, or those applications that have not chosen one of the accommodation options offered by the MKA.

#### Hotel Accommodation (Only for dogs UNDER 10kg)

Our partner hotel for exhibitors with dogs for this event is LYF Chinatown KL by Ascott (<u>https://lyfchinatown.com-kualalumpur.com/</u>) **Max 3 dogs** per room. Check in time is 3pm and Check out is 12noon. You are not able to leave dogs in the lobby. For guaranteed room availability prior to 3pm, the room must be pre-blocked a night before, chargeable at full day's rate. Any late check out until 6pm will be charged 50% of the room rate and the full rate will apply for check out after 6pm.

#### Room in shared Homestay Private House (For Dogs OVER 10kg)

For those with dogs over 10kg, we have managed to get a various private houses (AIR B&B) where you can stay together with your dogs. You have to bring your own towels and toiletries, etc. as this is a home stay concept home. All rooms are air-conditioned and all houses are shared by multiple exhibitors. Each room is private and only for your use (max 2 people per room). Dogs may be kept in the rooms.

#### Cost per night PER ROOM

Refundable Security Deposit of RM350 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. <u>The Landlord will return</u> <u>security deposit to you directly</u> upon checking out.

#### Please create an online account before proceeding with Online Entry!!

Before making online entries, please ensure you have the following documents available for acceptance of entry :

- 1. Vaccination Card of Animal Including Rabies and Regular Vaccinations, complete with Microchip number stated.
- 2. Passport Information page of the Person Traveling with the Dog
- 3. Flight Booking information/ Flight Ticket with complete Itinerary of the person traveling with the dog
- 4. Pedigree Certificate of the Dog, preferably with Microchip number stated.
- 5. Two colour photographs of the dog in the following poses dog sitting down facing camera with face clearly visible AND pic of the body of the dog (stacked) to be submitted at time of online entry.
- 6. Dogs from INDONESIA must comply with the entry requirements stated.

If any of the required forms are missing or illegible, we reserve the right to reject the application. We recommend you do your online entries early, so we can contact you if anything is missing or illegible!!

- MKA CAC's (Junior & Adult) will be awarded in **ALL CLASSES** for the class winners at **ALL** shows.
- Four Group placings will be awarded for the Adult Group.
- One placing will be awarded for Puppy, Junior, Veteran & Malaysian Bred classes In Group. There will be no Best Intermediate In Group or In Show.
- Three placings will be awarded for all In-Show Wins (BIS, Minor Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Veteran & Malaysian Bred).
- Minor Puppies (3-6 months) will not be judged during breed judging, but all together at Group Judging, with two dogs chosen to go on to compete for Best Minor Puppy In Show.

## Title Information

- To qualify for the title of Malaysian Champion a dog must be over 15 months old and win 6 CAC. Those below 15 months are eligible for the Malaysian Junior Champion title by winning 3 JCAC from Puppy and/or Junior Class.
- CACIB'S will be awarded at the FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOWS, to exhibits entered in the Intermediate, Open & Champion class ONLY. Junior & Veteran CACIBS will also be awarded at these shows to dogs entered in the Junior & Veteran Class.
- Winners of Dog & Bitch CACIB, Dog & Bitch winners from the Junior Class in Breed & Dog & Bitch winners from the Veteran Class in Breed at the FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW on 27<sup>th</sup> September, will be eligible for the title of Malaysian Winner 2025, Malaysian Junior Winner 2025 & Malaysian Veteran Winner 2025.
- Winners of Dog & Bitch CACIB, Dog & Bitch winners from the Junior Class in Breed & Dog & Bitch winners from the Veteran Class in Breed at the FCI A2O SECTION DOG SHOW will be eligible for the title of A2O Winner 2025, A2O Junior Winner 2025 & A2O Veteran Winner 2025.
- Winners of the BEST MALE & BEST FEMALE at the **MKA SOUTH EAST ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025 will be awarded SEA Champion Title.
- Winners of the BEST MALE & BEST FEMALE at the MKA FCI A20 CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW on 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> September, will be awarded A20 Champion CAC which goes towards their FCI A20 Champion Title.

FCI CACIB SHOWS (26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> Sept) - Docked and cropped dogs in these 11 breeds above will be permitted to enter these shows only if they were docked or cropped prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

ALL OTHER CAC SHOWS – all docked and cropped dogs in these 11 breeds will be allowed to participate, as MKA utilises amended MKA breed standards, which allows these eleven (11) breeds to be exhibited docked and/or cropped as they were previously allowed to be, without any time frame to date of birth. Dogs of these eleven (11) breeds that are NOT Docked and/or cropped will also be allowed to participate at shows and owners enter the show aware of docked & cropped are allowed and will be exhibited.

#### **Dogs from Indonesia**

The dog must have been continuously resident in Indonesia for not less than six (6) months or since its birth and free from any clinical sign of rabies. The dog has been vaccinated against rabies using rabies vaccine approved by exporting country for at least six (6) months prior to export according to the rabies vaccine manufacturer's recommendation. The animal shall have a blood sample taken for rabies antibody levels using FAVN or RFFIT not less than 3 months and not more than 12 months prior to export with acceptable result of 0.5 IU or more.

#### FCI World Grooming Championship 2025

Each team should ideally comprise of 5 members, but teams of 4 or less members will also be accepted, but, please take note that the scoring for teams will be based on the top four scores taken into consideration.

#### **Entry Fees**

RM1,125.00 per team

#### **MKA FCI International Grooming Competition**

Five (5) categories are offered in the competition. There are three (3) levels offered within each category .

3 levels will be offered : A – Advanced, Level B – Intermediate, Level C – Apprentice

For confirmation of entry into a category, participants must provide proof of certificates from an FCI recognized NCO grooming competition and be in good standing with their domestic NCO.

All Grooming Certification and Competition regulations are in accordance with official FCI Grooming regulations.

#### **MKA FCI International Grooming Competition and Certification Fees**

Registration Fee: RM150 Certificate Fees : a. Level "C" Certification: RM580 b. Level "B" Certification: RM680 c. Level "A" Certification: RM880

Dual Certification Policy – MKA now offer dual certification, MKA and FCI grooming certification, to all participants. FCI Certification can only be given to those participants who have observed the 12 month waiting period, i.e. following the attainment of the initial FCI certificate, contestants must observe a mandatory 12-month waiting period before advancing to the next FCI level. High scoring individuals that obtained 85 points (before November 2024) and above can be exempted from the 12-month waiting period. Participants that obtained 1<sup>st</sup> placing in a category (after November 2024) can also be exempted from the 12-month waiting period.

MKA recognizes grooming competition certificates/levels from all National Kennel Clubs affiliated to the FCI, fostering international collaboration and camaraderie within the grooming community. Participants holding an FCI/MKA Level C certification who wish to advance to Level B without the standard 12-month waiting period will only be eligible for the MKA Grooming Certificate (without the FCI certificate).

There will be no adjustment of the certification fees if one chooses to do just only MKA certification.

#### Dogs Used in Competition

The MKA will prepare the table for each competitor. Competitors must provide their own model dogs and their own grooming tools. Those who wish to hire model dogs should contact us directly. Those bringing their own model dogs must refer to the rules and regulations with regards to the importation of dogs into Malaysia provided in the General Information Section.
